

Post II Footlet KAL

Work in stockinette stitch following the star chart for the top of the foot and continuing the pattern as established for the bottom of the foot.

When you begin shaping for the toe, as indicated by the stair-steps on the chart, ignore the 2 places on the chart where 2 decreases at each edge are indicated and work only one decrease at each edge, as is done on all the other rows of the chart. Keeping a 2-stitch edge of MC gives a nice place to work the toe shaping. And remember to do the same shaping on the bottom of the foot.

This will give a footlet of approximately 10 inches. If you want a longer footlet, place rounds with no toe shaping in between the shaping rounds. If you want a shorter footlet, begin the shaping before indicated on the chart.

Finish as for plain footlet, with either a crochet edging or one of I-cord.
