

Unspun Icelandic Shaded Shawl Collared Vest (How to shade for Kimetha Young's Version)

These are instructions for shading only; you will need the shawl collared vest pattern to knit the garment. If you wish to use Unspun and do not have the book Handknitting with Meg Swansen (in which the pattern appears), let us know in the comments section of your wool order that you'd like the \$3 instructions for knitting Shawl Collared Vest.

Materials for dimensions of 40" width, 24" length (size S/M):

2 wheels Blacksheep, 1 wheel Steel, 1 wheel Silver, and 2 wheels Donahue (you'll have yarn left over; full wheels may be returned at any time)

Ribbing (2 inches), and first inch of vest, knit in 2 ply Blacksheep for total of 3". (Note From Kimetha: Black color in vest section might be better designed at 1.5" to give a total of 3.5" in the Black.)

Next section blends colors, 1 ply Blacksheep with 1 ply Steel, for 1 inch.

Solid color section of 2 ply Steel, for 3.5".

Next section blends colors, 1 ply Steel with 1 ply Silver, for 1 inch.

Solid color section of 2 ply Silver, for 3.5".

Next section blends colors, 1 ply Silver with 1 ply Donahue, for 1 inch.

Final color section completes vest in 2 ply Donahue.

Shawl collar added in 2 ply Blacksheep for contrast against the greys.
