## Errata for Animals in the Garden, from Double Knitting, by M'Lou Baber (This page was accidentally omitted from the book.; refer to pages 24-26)

## Directions:

With color A, cast on 150 sts.

**Border:** Work in Seed st for 2fi in (about 20 rows). You want this border to be as tall as 15 Seed sts are wide. When working Seed stitch, always purl the last stitch on each row, and slip the first stitch knitwise. This keeps the edges even.

**Next Row:** In this row, you need to continue the Seed st borders (15 sts on each side), and establish Double Knitting (see *Establishing DSPs* in the book) on the center 120 sts. Do this as follows: Using color A, sl1 knitwise, work Seed st for 14 sts. Loosely tie on color B. \*Byb (both yarns back), using color A, knit the first stitch and leave it on the left-hand needle. Byf (both yarns forward), using color B, purl the same stitch and remove it from the left-hand needle. Repeat from \* to last 15 sts, twist A and B yarns and, using color A only, work last 15 sts in Seed st.

Next row: Sl1 knitwise and work 14 sts in Seed st. DK (double knit) across to the last 15 sts. Twist A and B yarns and, using color A only, work last 15 sts in Seed st.

**Begin Chart:** Note that the 15-st borders are not shown on the chart. Work the 15 border sts, then follow the chart, repeating as indicated. Make sure to twist the two yarns at both ends of the blanket between the border and the body.

**Top Border:** Once you've completed the chart, you need to halve the number of stitches in the center section (all but the 15 border sts on each side). Do this as follows: Sl1 knitwise and work 14 sts in Seed st. Tie off color B, and using color A only, \*k2tog, p2tog, repeat from \* to last 15 sts. (Note: You are decreasing in the Seed st pattern. You may need to start decreasing with p2tog to keep your pattern in tact. Let your knitting dictate whether you start with a k2tog or p2tog.) Work last 15 sts in Seed st.

Continue in Seed st for twenty rows (or until the top border is the same size as the bottom border). Bind off.
