Technical Errors

Page	Correction
Page 61, charts:	<p>The legends for Charts A and B have the columns of color names reversed. The left-most column of color names (browns) should repeat every 3 rows, and the right column of names (blues) should repeat every 4 rows.</p> <p>The color legend shown here is correct for both Charts A and B.</p> <p>Note: The text on page 59 under the heading of "Color Sequence" is correct. Only the charts were reversed.</p>

Page 119, text:	<p>1) Gauge in Color Pattern should read: 34 stitches/<u>36</u> rows = 4" (10 cm).</p> <p>2) The last sentence of the third paragraph should read: You are back at start of round: <u>156</u> stitches.</p>
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Pages 127 and 128, charts:	<p>The legends for Charts A, B, and D have the column headers reversed. The left-most column of color names should have a darkened square at the top, and the right column of names should have a light square at the top.</p> <p>For this sweater only, the legend at the top of the charts should look like the one at the right.</p>
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Page 136, text:	In the list of wool, the color Silver should be color number 203 .
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Page 147, chart:	Chart G has an extra column of stitches. The chart is 35 stitches wide, and should only be 34 stitches wide. Ignore the left-most column of stitches.
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Page 173, text:	At the top of the left column, "Double Decrease at underarm every other round..." should be " Double Increase at underarm every other round..."
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Non-Technical Errors

(knit-picky things that we will fix for future printing)

Page	Correction
Table of Contents, second page:	Marion Poller should be <u>Marian Poller</u> . Heart Twin Set is on page <u>180</u> (not 189).
Page 3, text:	Last sentence of 5th paragraph should read: "You may now INCrease <u>or</u> DECrease the circumference of your garment in increments of 4 stitches."
Page 72, chart:	The second chart should be labeled <u>Chart C</u> .
Page 73, chart:	The vertical line indicating Center Front should be moved one stitch to the left (over the actual <u>center stitch</u>).
Page 74, text:	There is an <u>extra space</u> before the word "pattern" at the top of the second column.
Page 77, schematic:	The <u>arrow</u> indicating a 4 inch measurement should be located in the space between the center front neckline and the center back.
Page 84, photo:	The <u>model</u> should have removed the Palm Pilot from her front pocket. (This is a joke)
Page 100, text:	The words Snohomish Washington should be in <u>bold type</u> .
Page 101, text:	The word " <u>Continue</u> " should be at the top of the second column.
Page 105, text:	Requirement for "Needles" should include "Size 1 (2.25 mm) 16 or 24" circular ₂ ."
Page 105, chart:	The color listed on the chart as "Royal Heather" is the color we call " <u>Bressay Blue</u> ".
Page 126, chart:	The chart for ribbing should be labeled <u>Chart C</u> .
Page 130, chart:	The sixth stitch from the right on the 2nd row (a black square) should have a " <u>wrap and turn</u> " symbol in the stitch.
Page 150, text:	Ashes of Roses is color <u>FC51</u> .
Page 194, text:	Under Finishing, "seeks" should be " <u>steeks</u> ", and there should be no paren at the end of the sentence.
Page 195, text:	"Baste front opening shut and block" should be followed by a <u>period</u> .
Page 197, text:	"Block completed garment" should be followed by a <u>period</u> .
